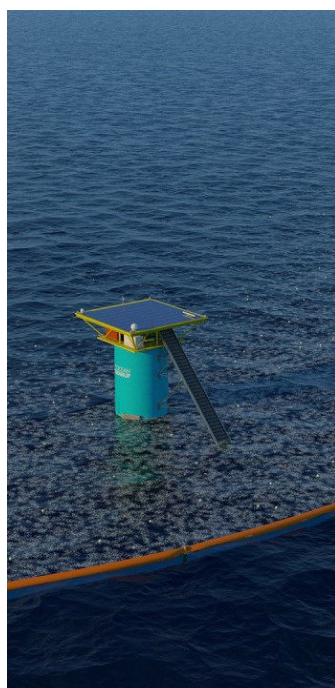
In between the speeches, the band "Since 21" played some songs. After that our PGA, Hana Mahmoud officially opened

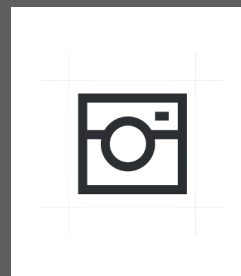

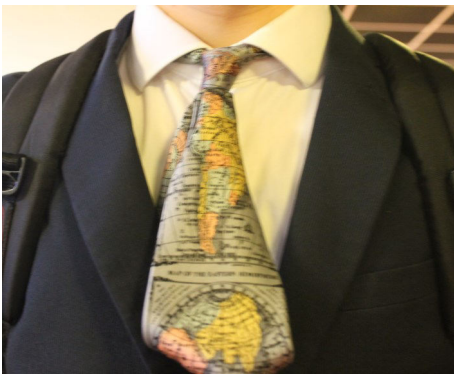
