A lot of people came to the party, so this was a success. Everyone

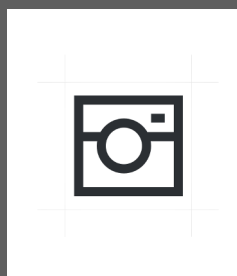
danced a lot, with as highlight, the macarena on the podium done by a lot of people.
